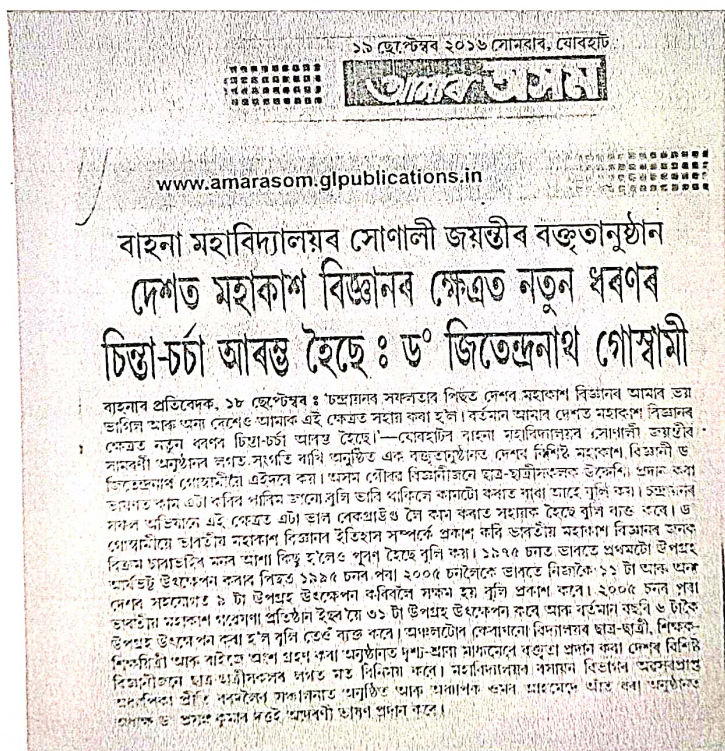


Report on Speech by Dr. Jitendranath Goswami on Space Exploration: Indian Science

Dr. Jitendranath Goswami, Eminent Indian Scientist, delivered a speech at Bahona College, Jorhat on 16.09.2016 on the occasion of Golden Jubilee Celebration of Bahona College. He spoke about the success story of Chandrayaan-1 and added a line "After successful mission of Chandrayaan-1, Indian Space Science has grown up with confidence and new ideas and innovations are developing among the Indian Space Scientists. The Assam Pride, Dr. Goswami motivated the students by saying "successful mission of Chandrayaan-1 has set up an example to all that nothing is impossible if you desire to do so. Dr. Goswami remembered about the contribution of Indian Space Scientist Vikram Sarabhai and told that successful mission of Chandrayaan would fulfil his dreams to some extent. He also poignantly pointed out that after first launching of satellite "Aryabhata" on 19th April, 1975, India has launched 11 satellites from 1995 to 2005 alone and 9 satellites with the help of other countries. He also pointed out that Indian Space organization "ISRO" has launched 31 satellites since 2005 and yearly 6 satellites have been launched already.

The speech was attended by around 45 faculties and 160 students from Bahona College and neighbourhood schools. This was followed by an attractive interaction session with faculties and students. Dr. Gopal Hazarika, Associate Professor of Dept. of Physics, Bhaona College, offered vote of thanks at the end of the program.
