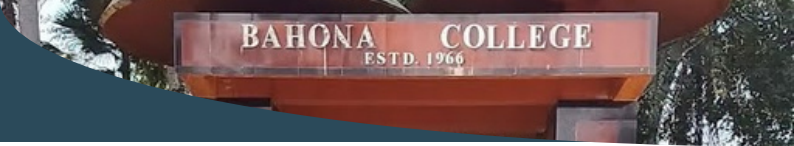

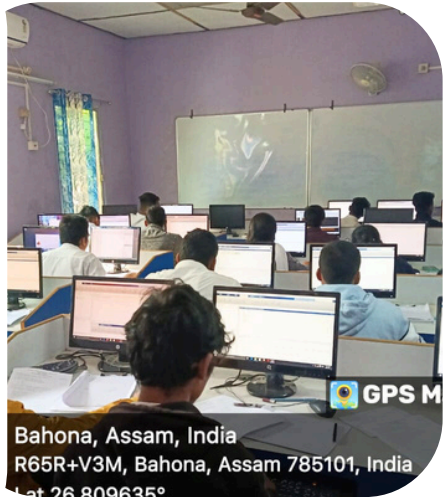

Dear Students, Faculty Members of the Bahona College Community

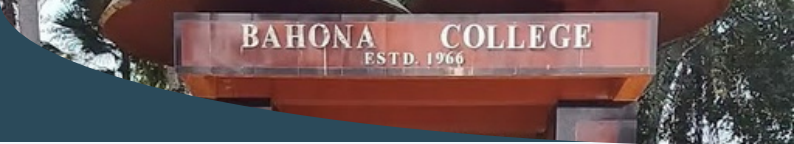

Message from Head of the Department:

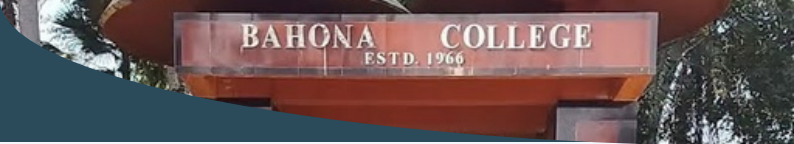
Greetings from Bahoana College!

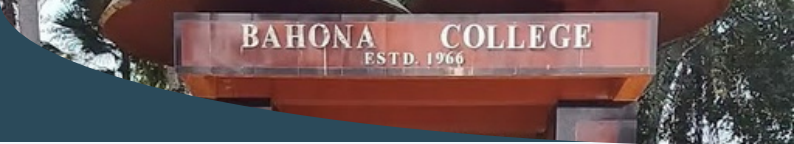


Message from Course Coordinator:

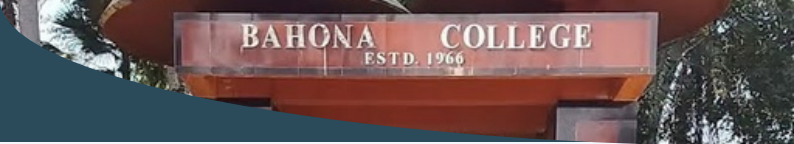
About Collaborative College

About the ITEP Programme

Bahona College offers the 4-year Integrated Teacher Education programme (ITEP) B.A. B.Ed/B.Sc. B.Ed (Middle & Secondary Level), a dual major undergraduate degree, from the academic year 2024-25. The Four Year ITEP is a milestone achievement in fulfilling one of the major mandates of National Education Policy 2020. The ITEP aims at the dual purpose of providing student teachers disciplinary knowledge along with the professional knowledge in an integrated manner. The program will be equivalent to an Undergraduate Degree (B.Sc./B.A.) and Teacher Education Degree. The curriculum of this program includes different courses and activities essential for both the degrees.

ITEP will be in multi and interdisciplinary academic environment and shall be implemented as per the guidelines of the NCTE and affiliating university. This program will prepare teachers for the new curricular and pedagogical structure of school education as reconfigured, to make it responsive and relevant to the developmental needs and interests of learners at different stages of their development, corresponding to the stages like Fundamental, Preparatory, Middle and Secondary guided by the 5+3+3+4 design. The ITEP will help all students who choose teaching as a profession after secondary, by choice. This integrated course will be beneficial for the students as they will save 1 year by completing this course in 4 years against the normal duration of 5 years as in the case of the existing B.Ed. programme. The programme has been permitted to share the existing physical resources of other departments of Bahona College

The course will contribute substantially to the revitalization of the whole teacher education sector. The prospective teachers passing out of this course through a multidisciplinary environment, reinvented Indian values and traditions will be instilled with the needs of 21st century on global standards. Hence, it will be largely helpful in shaping the future of Modern India.

Campus Facilities

LIBRARY

Bahona College Central Library is fully automated with Koha ILMS and barcode technology. It houses a collection of 36,000+ printed books and subscribes to 5 printed journals, 7 newspapers, and 10 magazines. The library is open from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM on all working days. Additionally, the library has a subscription to the N-LIST database. Apart from this, all the Departments are equipped with their departmental libraries for the use of their students and faculty members.



GIRLS' HOSTEL

Shared Rooms and Located within the college premises, the Girls' Hostel provides hygienic living conditions with personalised care. Seats in the girls' hostel will be offered to applicants on a merit basis, and the list will be uploaded a few days after the completion of the admission process.



BOYS' HOSTEL

Shared Rooms and Located in a walkable distance from the college premises, the Boys' Hostel provides hygienic living conditions with personalised care. While any male student may apply for the Boys Hostel, preference will be given to students belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.



LABORATORY

The science departments and Department of Education have well-equipped and state-of-the-art laboratories for practical class. There are 3 well-equipped computer laboratories for computer practical classes with provision for accommodating 50 students at a time.



CANTEEN

A healthy mind can reside only in a healthy body. The canteen at Bahona College is perfect to refresh after the hectic class schedule. It provides the students the much-needed platform to ease and re-energise for the subsequent sessions. Also, it provides a space for professional dialogue where faculties and students can discuss on various areas of interest over a cup of tea or coffee.

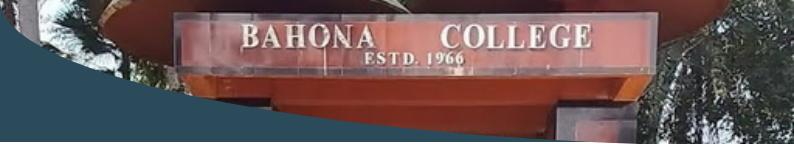




Admission Guidelines of ITEP, B.A./B.Sc.B.Ed (Middle & Secondary level)

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- ✓ Candidates with minimum 50% marks in Senior Secondary or plus two examination or its equivalent (under 5+3+3+4 pattern) from a recognized board are eligible for Entrance Examination.
- ✓ The relaxation in the reservation for Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe or Other Backward Class or Persons with Disabilities or Economically Weaker Section and any other categories shall be as per the rules of the State Government.
- ✓ A single nation-wide entrance test called National Common Entrance Test (hereinafter referred to as 'NCET') will be conducted by NTA for admission to the 4 Year ITEP under the recommendations of NEP 2020.
- ✓ The mode of examination (NCET) shall be online/Computer Based Test (hereinafter referred to as 'CBT') in multilingual pattern and its score would reflect the relative performance level of the candidate for merit-based selection to secure the admission. Scorecard shall be prepared by NTA and admission shall be done through centralized online counseling.



ADMISSION PROCESS:

- ✓ Only candidates who have qualified the National Common Entrance Test are eligible to apply for admission.
- ✓ Admission will be conducted through Samarth Portal as accordance with the guidelines of the NCTE
- ✓ At the time of admission to the programme, the candidate must indicate the subjects/discipline (B.A. B.Ed./B.Sc. B.Ed.).
- ✓ The merit list will be published on both the Samarth Portal and the College Website.
- ✓ Selected candidates must attend the college for verification and admission on the notified date.



RESERVATIONS POLICY (COLLEGE)

For admission into ITEP as directed by Government of Assam shall be applicable. For Four Year Undergraduate Programme, reservation policy as directed by Dibrugarh University shall be applicable

Category	Reservation of Seats
Scheduled Caste (SC)	7%
Scheduled Tribe-Plains (STP)	10%
Scheduled Tribe- Hills (STH)	5%
Other Backward Classes (OBC/MOBC)	15%
Differently Abled	5%

Note: Candidates seeking admission under the aforementioned reserved categories must submit case certificate of disability with a photograph duly signed by competent authority (Deputy Commissioner or his nominee) along application forms.
