Three National Education Policies (1968, 1986 and 2020) were introduced in India in the past. The emphasis of previous policies on education was mainly on issues of access to education. The National Education Policy-2020 has been brought in keeping in view the current and future needs, which is expected to usher in large scale transformation to both the school and higher education sectors. To achieve full human potential quality education is a fundamental requirement. It is a must for the development of a just and equitable society and for promotion of national development. The whole world is undergoing rapid changes in the knowledge landscape. In this context, the new educational policy (NEP) will replace 34 years old National Education Policy framed in 1986.

The National Education Policy- 2020 (NEP) has a vision to reinstate India in the coveted position of world educational leader at global level. It provides an opportunity to the Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) especially those engaged in technical education, to create a system that contributes directly to transforming the country into a global knowledge superpower. This Policy aims for an inclusive and equitable Education System. At Higher education level it aspires to introduce broad-based, multi-disciplinary, holistic education with flexible curricula, creative combinations of subjects, integration of vocational education and multiple entries and exit points with appropriate certification.

The basic aims of the programme included in the NEP are to create an all inclusive environment to provide social, emotional and academic support to students of under privileged section. It also provides to promote traditional knowledge and enable local people to participate in Atma Nirbhar Bharat. It also offers to develop Skill based Training Modules to improve employability and creates prospects of self-employment towards creating and sharing pooled resources among logically networked Institutions.

The proposed Seminar will highlight all the concerned issues of NEP-2020 and discuss the same in scholastic area for propagation of its mission and dissemination of new ideas.
