1. INTRODUCTION: (TIMES NEW ROMAN, FONT SIZE 12)

Manuscript may contain Introduction, Literature Survey, Methodology, Results, Discussion, Conclusion, Acknowledgments, and References etc. Authors can format their manuscript according to their needs, using Times New Roman, Font Size 12, single spaced, and justified. Equations should be written in Word using Microsoft Equation or MathType add-on and number equations consecutively with parentheses flush with the right margin.

2. GUIDELINES FOR GRAPHICS AND TABULAR PREPARATION:

Figures should be in jpg, jpeg and png format. Table should not be inserted in the form of image (Table should be created on MS Word using Table toolbar). Place figure captions below the figures; place table titles above the tables. Both are Times New Roman, font size 10, center aligned, and sentence case. When referencing your figures within your paper, use the abbreviation "Fig. 1" even at the beginning of a sentence. Tables should be numbered with Roman Numerals. Use "Table I" for referring a table within text.
